Above is part of the poem, entitled “The Pillar of Cloud”, which was written by Blessed Cardinal John Henry Newman in 1833. He wrote it while he was in Italy. In the trip, he fell seriously sick and was at the verge of death. Far from his beloved home, England, Newman battled with his raging fever.

In the midst of uncertainties ahead, he held onto to God, His kindly Light. Not asking to see what was ahead of him, Newman trusted that God would lead him on.

This is one of my favourite poems. It speaks to me, especially in my moments of struggles as I confront the darkness of doubts and fears, and it draws me to have the inner strength to take the next step in the face of the unknown. Amid the encircling gloom, I know that God, my kind and gentle Light, will lead me.

I have faith that God is with me...in the same way that He is with you.

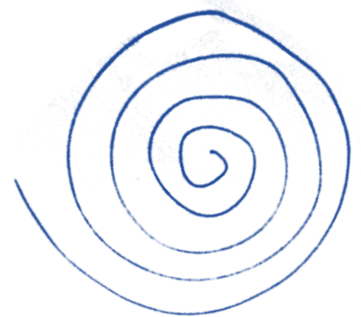

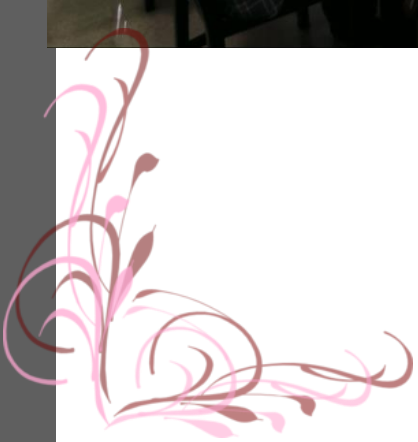
