On Easter morning, the world woke up to the tragic news of bombings of churches and hotels in Sri Lanka. As Christians gathered in their churches to worship and celebrate the Feast of Christ's Resurrection and people eating their Easter breakfast in the hotel restaurants, suicide bombers carried out the deadly attacks that claimed hundreds of innocent lives. The violent and savage bombings in Sri Lanka on Easter Sunday morning casted a shadow over the Good News of Easter that speaks of the joyful and triumphant victory of Life over suffering and death. It somehow made everything seemed wrong. How then to make sense of this brutal reality? And not just this event, but all the painful events of our personal lives such as a haunting failure, a painful sickness, a sad loss of someone, etc. Does the Alleluia of Easter makes sense? Does the joy of the Easter continue to be a reality today? What does our faith in the Resurrected Christ mean?

I do not have the answer. I cannot say that I understand. All I know that each day is a new day to hold onto the hope that opens my heart to see goodness in the world, in the people around me and in myself; as well as to believe, that beyond darkness, there is always light. 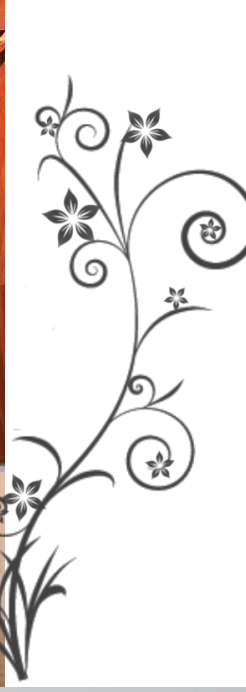
